The highlighted are the rates that you will be invoiced quarterly based on 3,000 gallon consumption. The increments are also shown as to how much the rates will change over the next three years. The Orders are part of By-Law No. 3-2019 (Shoal Lake) and By-Law No. 5-2019 (Strathclair).




Manitoba Agricultural Services Corporation Farmland School Tax Rebate 2019

The Farmland School Tax Rebate (FSTR) was implemented in 2004 to support the rural economy by providing Manitoba farmland owners with school tax relief. Landowners are required to submit an annual application to Manitoba Agricultural Services Corporation (MASC). As a courtesy to ratepayers, the R.M. of Yellowhead staff was sending the rebate forms in to MASC for them. Unfortunately the R.M. of Yellowhead will no longer be offering this service. When landowners pay for their taxes, we will stamp the rebate and return it to the customer. The landowners are to make sure their rebate gets to MASC by the deadline. Sorry for any inconvenience this may cause.
