Manitoba Agricultural Services Corporation Farmland School Tax Rebate 2019

The Farmland School Tax Rebate (FSTR) was implemented in 2004 to support the rural economy by providing Manitoba farmland owners with school tax relief. Landowners are required to submit an annual application to Manitoba Agricultural Services Corporation (MASC). As a **courtesy** to ratepayers, the R.M. of Yellowhead staff was sending the rebate forms in to MASC for them. Unfortunately the R.M. of Yellowhead will no longer be offering this service. When landowners pay for their taxes, we will stamp the rebate and return it to the customer. The landowners are to make sure their rebate gets to MASC by the deadline. Sorry for any inconvenience this may cause.

2019 Education Property Tax Credit Changes

Manitoba Budget 2018 announced that, effective for the 2019 tax year, the calculation of the Manitoba Education Property Tax Credit (EPTC) will be based on school taxes and the \$250 deductible before the EPTC applies will be eliminated. This change may result in an increase in your property taxes.

What's Up Yellowhead?

July 2019

Since being elected to Council in October of 2018 I have been a member the Yellowhead Broadband Committee. I have to admit I wasn't a believer in what the committee was trying to achieve. I had questions and reservations. The goal of the municipality and committee was to provide high speed wireless internet service to all of the residents at a reasonable cost. At \$55 a month for Yellowhead residents, I don't think you can say that it's not reasonable. Anywhere from 30 to 90 mbps download speed is fast for any area. Unlimited data download for no cost in this area was almost unheard of before YHBB started offering it, and now other internet service providers have had to follow suit just to stay competitive. As of June 1, 2019 YHBB has 350 resident and 32 non resident connections RM of Yellowhead continues to be monitored by other RM's to see how we did it! From my personal experience of having YHBB as my Internet Service Provider since October of 2018 it is reliable and quick.

I have to commend the former Yellowhead Council, the Yellowhead Broadband committee and all others involved for their foresight and their work to achieve what they've done. I can say that my mind set has changed. Well done to the municipality, the committee and the tech's that made it happen!

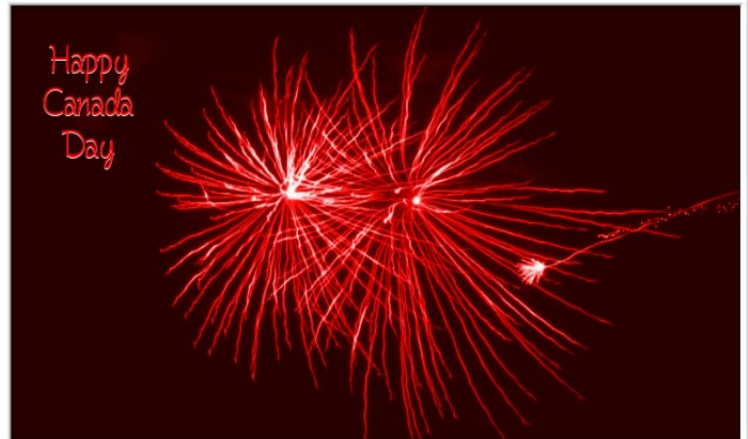
